**Shop Trading Hours (Abolition of Restrictions) Bill** 

#### Proposed amendment

Graham Kelly, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

New clause 2D

To insert, after *clause 2* on page 1, the following clause:

- 2D Effect of certain provisions in leases, etc Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by inserting, after subsection (2B), the following subsections:
- "(2C) A mandatory opening provision in a lease, licence, contract, covenant, or agreement entered into, or made, before the Shop Trading Hours Act Repeal Act (Abolition of Restrictions) Amendment Act 2002 came into force must not be interpreted as requiring a shop to open on a day that was listed in section 3(1) immediately before that Act came into force.
- "(2D) **Subsection (2C)** does not apply to a shop that was entitled to open on that day, before the Shop Trading Hours Act Repeal Act (Abolition of Restrictions) Amendment Act **2002** came into force, under section 4."

#### **Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Shop Trading Hours (Abolition of Restrictions) Bill by inserting *new clause 2D*, which protects a shop owner or occupier from being forced to open their shop on a day that was formerly listed in section 3(1) of the principal Act as a result of the restrictions on trading on those days being abolished.
