SOCIAL WELFARE ACTS AMENDMENT BILL
Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 4 Bills

Hon. Dr MICHAEL CULLEN, in Committee, to move as follows:

That Part I (*clauses 2 to 4*) be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Department of Social Welfare Act
1971**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Department of Social Welfare Amendment Act 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Department of Social Welfare Act 1971 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That Part II (*clauses 5 to 8*) be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 5* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Disabled Persons Community
Welfare Act 1975**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Disabled Persons Community Welfare Amendment Act 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Disabled Persons Community Welfare Act 1975 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That Part III (*clauses 9 to 35*) and the Schedule be a separate Bill, and the for *clause 9* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Social Security Act 1964

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Social Security Amendment Act (No. 2) 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security Act 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That Part IV (*clauses 36 to 51*) be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 36* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the War Pensions Act 1954

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the War Pensions Amendment Act 1988, and shall be

read together with and deemed part of the War Pensions Act 1954 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1989.
