SOCIAL WELFARE REFORM BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. PETER GRESHAM, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 36: To omit subclause (3) (page 19, lines 40 to 44), and substitute the following subclause:

(3) Section 80 (8) of the principal Act (as so substituted) is hereby amended by repealing paragraph (b) of the proviso, and substituting the following paragraph:

“(b) Where a person in receipt of a veteran’s pension or New Zealand Superannuation (to whom paragraph (a) of this proviso does not apply) dies, the benefit shall cease on the date of death.”.

To add the following subclause:

(6) **Subsection (3)** of this section shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 36: The new subclause (3) provides for the amendment, set out in the Bill, to paragraph (b) of the proviso to section 80 (8) of the principal Act to proceed.

In addition, the new subclause (3) provides that a veteran’s pension or New Zealand superannuation paid to a single beneficiary who dies, ceases on the date of death rather than on the day following the pay day immediately preceding the date of death.

The new subclause (3) is deemed to have come into force on 1 July 1995.
