MAGISTRATES' COURTS BILL.

Hon. Mr. Reeves to move, That clauses 15 and 30 be recommitted, for the purpose of amending the same as follows:—

Clause 15: To omit all the words of the clause after "shall," in line 27, and to substitute in lieu thereof "hold office at the pleasure of the Governor."

Clause 30: To add the following words to subsection (a) thereof:—

Excepting in actions for false imprisonment or illegal arrest, or for malicious prosecution, or for libel or slander, or for seduction, or for breach of promise of marriage.

TRAMWAYS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

The Hon. Mr. Seddon to move the following amendments:—

Clause 4: Subsection (1), omit the words "a wire or," and the word "con-

ductor"; also add the following proviso to the subsection:

Provided always that wires or conductors, or any other means so erected, shall in every case form a closed metallic circuit, and have no earth-contact through their entire length, and be entirely free from connection with water or gas mains or pipes.

Clause 5: Add the following paragraph:—

Any local authority, company, or person affected by any rule or regulation made by the Commissioner may appeal to the Board of Control against such rule or regulation; and, notwithstanding any such delegation, the Board of Control may, if it thinks fit, require the Commissioner to repeal or amend such rule or regulation, or make any new rule or regulation in substitution of or in addition to the same.
