TRANSPORT AMENDMENT BILL

## Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr Gordon, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 8, subclause (2): To omit from the proposed subsection (6B) of section 58D of the principal Act the word "him" in line 6 on page 18, and substitute the words "the first-mentioned person".

Clause 16, subclause (2): To insert in the proposed paragraph (db) of section 113 (1) of the principal Act, after the words "carried on" in line 1 on page 23, the words ", otherwise than by means of a heavy motor vehicle,".

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 8 (2): This is a drafting amendment in order to make it clear that the person referred to is the person who handed to a constable or traffic officer the container containing the specimen of blood and not the person by whom the specimen was taken.

Clause 16 (2): The effect of this amendment is that the exemption from transport licensing conferred by the proposed new paragraph (db) will not apply if the vehicle used is a heavy motor vehicle.
