TARIFF BILL.

Captain Russell, on the motion for the second reading of the Tariff Bill, to move,—

That, in the opinion of this House, the tariff resolutions altering the duties of Customs should be rescinded, on the grounds that by them—

(1.) No simplification of the tariff is effected;

(2.) Few existing anomalies are abolished;

(3.) No appreciable relief is granted to anybody, while extra burdens are imposed upon many; and

(4.) The estimated increase in the revenue—viz., £10,300—is not commensurate with the general disarrangement of trade.
