TOWN DISTRICTS BILL.

Mr. WITTY, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

A. The provisions of subsection three of section one hundred and seventeen of "The Public Works Act, 1905," shall not be applicable either to this or the principal Act.

B. The Board shall have and may exercise the powers conferred on municipal corporations by section two hundred and thirty-eight of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1900," in respect to the making of by-laws with regard to the erection of buildings, and may in such by-laws provide for the granting of building permits and for the fixing and collection of fees for such permits, and also for prohibiting or regulating the removal of old buildings into town districts.
