# **Supplementary Order Paper**

### **Tertiary Education Reform Bill**

Proposed amendments

Nandor Tanczos, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

#### Clause 5A

To insert in *new section 159AA*, after *subsection (2)* (after line 6 on page 8), the following subsection:

"(2A) The tertiary education strategy must set out how progress in implementing the strategy is to be monitored and reported on.

#### Clause 6

To add to *new section 159D* (after line 8 on page 11), as *subsections (2) and (3)*, the following subsections:

- "(2) At least 2 months before appointing a member (other than a replacement member appointed under clause 11(1) of Schedule 13A), the Minister must advertise his or her intention to appoint a member and must seek responses from interested persons.
- "(3) **Subsection (2)** does not apply if the Minister appoints as a member a person who, immediately before the appointment, was a member of the Transition Tertiary Education Commission.

### **Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper inserts 2 new requirements into the Tertiary Education Reform Bill. These are—

- that the tertiary education strategy must set out how progress in implementing the strategy is to be monitored and reported on:
- that the Minister must advertise and calls for expressions of interest before appointing members to the Tertiary Education Commission. This requirement will not apply to members of the Transition Tertiary Education Commission who are appointed to the Commission because their original appointments were advertised and they should simply "roll over" into the Commission once it is established.
