Tertiary Education Reform Bill

*Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills*

Hon Steve Maharey, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clause 1, Part 1, Part 2, and Schedules 1 and 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clause 1*, the *Part 1* heading, *clause 2*, the *Part 2* heading, and *clause 4* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Education (Tertiary Reform) Amendment Act **2002**.
- (2) In this Act, the Education Act 1989<sup>1</sup> is called "the principal Act".

**2 Commencement**

- (1) This Act, other than the sections referred to in **subsections (2) to (4)**, comes into force on **1 January 2003**.
- (2) **Section 15AA** comes into force on **1 July 2003**.
- (3) **Sections 12, 13, 13A, and 17** come into force on **1 January 2004**.
- (4) **Sections 17A to 17D** come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 3 and Schedules 3 and 4* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading and *clause 38* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Industry Training Amendment Act **2002**.
- (2) In this Act, the Industry Training Act 1992<sup>2</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

- (1) This Act, other than the sections referred to in **subsection (2)**, comes into force on **1 January 2003**.
- (2) **Sections 39(3) and (4), 40(1), (2), and (4), 41(1) and (2), 42(1), (2), and (5), 43, 44(2), (6), (7), and (8), 45A, 45B, 45C, 45E, and 46A** come into force on **1 January 2004**.

**Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper replaces Supplementary Order Paper No 24, which was released on 15 October 2002. The replacement is necessary to reflect a change to the commencement dates. The Supplementary Order Paper divides the Tertiary Education Reform Bill into the following 2 Bills:

- the Education (Tertiary Reform) Amendment Bill:
  - the Industry Training Amendment Bill.
