### **Tertiary Education Reform Bill**

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon Steve Maharey, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, clause 1, Part 1, Part 2, and Schedules 1 and 2 be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, clause 1, the Part 1 heading, clause 2, the Part 2 heading, and clause 4, there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

#### The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Education (Tertiary Reform) Amendment Act
- (2) In this Act, the Education Act 1989<sup>1</sup> is called "the principal Act".

- 2 Commencement
- (1) This Act, other than the sections referred to in subsection (2), comes into force on 1 July 2002.
- (2) Sections 12, 13, 13A, and 17 come into force on 1 January 2004.

That *Part 3* and *Schedules 3 and 4* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading and *clause 38* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

#### The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Industry Training Amendment Act 2002.

- (2) In this Act, the Industry Training Act 1992<sup>2</sup> is called "the principal Act".

- 2 Commencement
- (1) This Act, other than the sections referred to in subsection (2), comes into force on 1 July 2002.
- (2) Sections 39(3) and (4), 40(1), (2), and (4), 41(1) and (2), 42(1), (2), and (5), 43, 44(2), (6), (7), and (8), 45A, 45B, 45C, 45E, and 46A come into force on 1 January 2004.
