## HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

### TRANSPORT LAW AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. SEMPLE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clauses 4 and 5: To omit these clauses.

Clause 6, subclause (1): To omit the words “in the last preceding section and” in lines 37 and 38.

Clause 6, subclause (2), paragraph (a): To omit the words “or of bicycles” in line 6.

Clause 6, subclause (2), paragraph (e): To omit this paragraph.

Clause 11, subclause (1): To add the following words: “Every traffic district shall comprise a continuous area having no points distant more than fifteen miles from the post-office, or chief post-office, or principal post-office, as the case may be, in the borough of which the enforcement authority is the Council.”

Clause 11, subclause (5): To omit the words “the sole” in line 33.

Clause 11, subclause (6): To omit this subclause, and substitute the following new subclause:—

(6A) All fees received under section twenty-three of the principal Act in respect of motor-drivers' licenses by any local authority (not being the enforcement authority) while its district is included in any traffic district shall be paid by that local authority to the enforcement authority, subject to the deduction of one shilling in respect of each license, and shall form part of the general funds of the enforcement authority.

Clause 12: To insert the words “or county” after the word “borough” in lines 9, 10, and 13.

(NOTE.—This amendment will necessitate the insertion of the words “and County Councils” in the sidenote after the word “Councils”.)

Clause 14: To omit this clause.

Clause 15, subclause (1): To omit the words “(being registered as an engineer under the Engineers Registration Act, 1924)” in lines 22 and 23.

(NOTE.—This amendment will necessitate the omission of the marginal reference “See Reprint of Statutes, Vol. I, p. 381.”)

Clause 16: To omit paragraphs (b) and (c); to add the following new paragraph:—

(d) Providing for the exemption, either wholly or partially, and either unconditionally or upon or subject to such conditions as may be prescribed by or in accordance with the regulations, of persons visiting New Zealand from overseas, or of their motor-vehicles, or of any classes of such persons or motor-vehicles, from any of the requirements of the principal Act or of regulations made under that Act.

Clause 19, subclause (2): To omit this subclause.

(NOTE.—This amendment will necessitate the omission of “(1)” in line 20.)

Clause 20, subclause (2), paragraph (b): To omit the words “for him” in line 9.

Clause 20, subclause (3): To omit this subclause.
