Taxation Reform Bill (No. 2)

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 3 Bills

Hon. R. O. Douglas, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 2 to 39* and the Schedules be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Income Tax Act 1976

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Income Tax Amendment Act (No. 4) 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Income Tax Act 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 40 to 48* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 40* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Land Tax Act 1976

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Land Tax Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Land Tax Act 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That clauses 49 to 52 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 49 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act my be cited as the Estate and Gift Duties Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968.
