TAXATION REFORM BILL (NO. 3)

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 2 Bills

Hon. WYATT CREECH, in Committee, to move the following motion:

That *Part I* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Income Tax Act 1976

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Income Tax Amendment Act (No. 3) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Income Tax Act 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as otherwise provided in this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal

assent.

That Part II be a separate Bill, and that for clause 35 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985
BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Goods and Services Tax Amendment Act (No. 3) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
