### TEACHERS' SUPERANNUATION ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. FOWLDS, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 11, subclause (2): After the words "such sum," in line 37, insert "to the words 'per annum' inclusive."

To insert new clauses:—

Male contributors retiring at age fifty-five entitled to benefits of fund on certain conditions.

9A. Where any male contributor whose age is not less than fifty-five years, and whose length of service is not less than twenty-five years, retires from the Education service, he shall continue to be entitled to all the benefits of the fund if, at the time of his retirement, he pays into the fund a sum equal to the total amount of the contributions that would be payable by him until he reached the age of sixty years and three months, computed on the basis of the highest annual rate of salary received by him during the two years preceding his retirement:

Provided that he shall not be entitled to receive any retiring-allowance under section twelve of the principal Act until he reaches the age of sixty years and three months.

Further provision as to return to duty.

13A. The *last preceding* section hereof shall apply only where the retiring-allowance is granted under section twelve of the principal Act; and section eighteen of the principal Act shall apply only where the retiring-allowance is granted under section thirteen of that Act.
