TOKELAU (TERRITORIAL SEA AND EXCLUSIVE ECONOMIC ZONE) BILL

Proposed Amendments

Right Hon. Mr TALBOYS, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 2: To omit the definition of the term "fish", on page 2, and substitute the following definition:

"Fish" means every kind of marine animal and its young, fry, eggs, or spawn; and includes shellfish, crustaceans, sponge, holothurian (bêche-de-mer), and turtle:

To insert after the definition of the term "foreshore", on page 2, the following definition:

"Foreign fishing craft" means any fishing craft that is not a Tokelauan fishing craft:

To add to this clause, on page 3, the following definition:

"Tokelauan fishing craft" means a fishing craft in which no person who is not a Tokelauan has any legal or equitable interest (except by way of security only for any advance made by him to the owner).

Clause 8 (1): To insert in paragraph (a), after the word "fish" in line 13 on page 5, the words "(other than marine mammals)".

To insert after paragraph (d) on page 5 the following paragraph:

(da) Providing separate licensing procedures for marine mammals:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 2: The first amendment extends the definition of "fish" to cover all marine animals.

The second amendment defines "foreign fishing craft".

The third amendment defines "Tokelauan fishing craft".

Clause 8: The amendments enable separate control procedures to be established for marine mammals.
