UNEMPLOYMENT AMENDMENT BILL.

AMENDMENT proposed by His Excellency the Governor-General:—

Clause 12: To omit the words “and at all times heretofore to have been” in the seventh line.

To add the following new subclause:—

(2) This section shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and thirty-four, and to have applied with respect to income received for the year ended on the thirty-first day of March preceding that date.
