UNIVERSITY OF AUCKLAND BILL

Proposed Amendments

MR Douglas, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 6, subclause (2), paragraph (d): To omit the word "six", and insert the word "five".

Clause 6, subclause (2), paragraph (e): To omit this paragraph, and substitute the following paragraph:

(e) One member to be elected by the governing bodies of State secondary schools, technical schools, and combined schools and such registered private secondary schools as the Council may from time to time determine, being in all cases schools situated in the University of Auckland university district, each governing body to have the number of votes specified in subsection (3) of this section.

Clause 6, subclause (2), paragraph (h): To omit this paragraph, and substitute the following paragraph:

(h) One member, being a member of the Auckland City Council, to be appointed by that Council.

Clause 6, subclause (2): To add the following new paragraphs:

(i) Two members of Parliament to be elected by such of the members of the House of Representatives as for the time being represent electoral districts within the University of Auckland university district.

(j) One member to be elected by those teachers employed in State secondary schools, technical schools, combined schools, district high schools, or registered private secondary or technical schools (excluding any intermediate or lower departments) situated in the University of Auckland university district who are graduates of any university or whose names are registered in the Teachers' Register.

Clause 6: To insert the following new subclause:

(3) For the purposes of an election under paragraph (e) of subsection (2) of this section, the governing body of each school shall have—

(a) One vote for every hundred pupils; and

(b) If it has any number of pupils in excess of all multiples of one hundred, one vote for that number.

Clause 24, subclause (2), paragraphs (d) and (f): To omit these paragraphs.
