FRIENDLY SOCIETIES ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Sir GEORGE GREY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

In the first line of clause 2, after “be” to insert the words, “or shall have been.”

In line 8 of the same clause, after the word “month” to insert the words, “after the passing of this Act or.”

UNIVERSITY OF OTAGO COUNCIL ELECTION BILL.

Hon. Mr. W. P. REEVES, in Committee, to move:—

Add to clause 2 “and the word ‘professors’ means professors and lecturers appointed by the Council.”

After clause 7 insert—

7A. The Council shall convene a meeting of professors whenever a vacancy shall occur in the Council requiring to be filled by a member elected by the professors as hereinafter provided, and at such meeting the professors shall have power to elect one of their own number or some other person to be a member of the Council.

Omit clause 9, substitute—

9. Vacancies occurring through the death or resignation of members of the Council in office at the time of passing of this Act shall be filled by persons elected or nominated, as the case may be, in the following order—that is to say, the first, third, fifth, sixth, and seventh vacancies shall be filled by persons elected by the graduates, the second and fourth vacancies by persons elected by the professors, and the remaining vacancies by persons appointed by the Governor in Council.

9A. Every vacancy occurring through the death or retirement of any member of Council appointed or elected under this Act shall be filled by a person appointed or elected by the authority by which the deceased or retiring member was appointed or elected.

For clause 12 substitute—

12. Except as provided in section *nine* of this Act no professor may be appointed or elected to be a member of the Council.
