### WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR ACCIDENTS BILL.

Rt. Hon. R. J. SEDDON, in Committee, to move the following new clause :—

Care of injured  
workers to be  
at cost of  
employer.

4. (1.) In any case of accident to a worker when engaged at his employment it shall be the duty of his employer to furnish prompt medical and other aid to the injured person, and to provide for his physical relief and welfare.

(2.) The expenses so incurred may be reviewed by the Court of Arbitration, which may fix the share or liability of the parties interested, and in making any award for compensation may have regard to the amount so incurred.
