WAIPORI FALLS ELECTRICAL POWER BILL.

Mr. Millar to move, on consideration of the Report of the Waipori Falls Electrical Power Bill, the following amendments:—

That the Committee be revived, and the Bill be referred back to them for the consideration of the following amendments:—

Preamble: In lines 15 and 16, to strike out the words "the City of Dunedin."

Clause 10: In lines 13 and 14, to strike out the words "the City of Dunedin" and "Caversham."

To strike out clause 14.

Mr. Arnold to move, on consideration of the Report on the Waipori Falls Electrical Power Bill, the following amendment:—

That the Committee be revived, and the Bill be referred back to them for the consideration of the omission of all the words after "Caversham" in line nine of the new proviso to clause three.

That the Committee be revived, and the Bill be referred back to them for the consideration of the omission of the new clauses 3A and 3B, and the substitution of a provision for obtaining the consent of local authorities before opening up roads and executing other necessary works in the districts under the jurisdiction of such authorities.
