WINE MAKERS LEVY BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr MACINTYRE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 6: To omit from line 29 on page 3 the word "production", and to substitute the word "sold".

To omit from line 34 on page 3 the words "the previous", and to substitute the word "that".

Clause 7: To omit from lines 4 and 5 on page 4 the words "wine production", and to substitute the words "amount of wine sold".

Clause 19A: To insert, after clause 19 on page 10, the following clause:

19A. **Transitional provisions**—For the purposes of providing the first annual levy under this Act—

- (a) Section 6 (1) of this Act (which relates to returns of wine sold) shall be read as if the reference to the last day of November in any year were a reference to the 15th day of February 1977; and
- (b) Section 7 of this Act (which relates to the trustee advising the Institute of the aggregate amount of wine sold) shall be read as if the reference to the last day of December in any year were a reference to the last day of February in 1977.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The proposed amendments to *clauses 6 and 7* are consequential on changing the basis of the levy from wine manufactured to wine sold.

The proposed *clause 19A* allows the Wine Institute to collect the first year's levy in 1977 which, with the effluxion of time, would not otherwise have been collected until 1978.
