NOTICES RELATING TO ORDERS OF THE DAY.

MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. BARRON, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

Sections ninety-two to ninety-six inclusive of the said Act are hereby repealed.

The Governor may, from time to time, appoint any one or more person or persons, as he shall think fit, to be an Auditor or Auditors for any Council, and from time to time remove any such person or persons, and on the death, resignation, or removal of any such Auditor or Auditors may appoint any other person in place of any person or persons so dying, resigning, or being removed.

The Governor may direct that such reasonable salary or remuneration as he thinks fit may be paid to such Auditor or Auditors, and the amount thereof shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund.

Mr. J. B. FISHER, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Section twenty-two of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876," is hereby repealed, and the following section enacted in place thereof:—

If not less than a majority of two-thirds of the individual burgesses of a divided borough petition the Governor to alter the boundaries of such wards, or to redivide the borough into other wards, the Governor shall, by Proclamation, alter the boundaries of any wards, or may redivide the borough into new wards, with such names and boundaries as shall be named in the petition.

WELLINGTON PROVINCIAL DISTRICT HIGHWAY BOARDS BILL.

Major WILLIS, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

**3.** The Governor may exercise the powers conferred by the twenty-fourth section of "The Highways Act, 1874," when the time for holding an election of a Warden or Wardens has elapsed, and no such election has from any cause been held; and such powers may be exercised upon such evidence as the Governor thinks fit. All appointments of Wardens hitherto made under the said section shall be deemed valid, and as if the same had been made under the powers thereby conferred.
