

SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Tuesday, the 5th day of September, 1871.

1. Amendments reported from the Select Committee on the Wellington Reclaimed Land Bill:—

To be added to Clause 1.

So much of this Act as relates to the issuing of debentures by the Corporation aforesaid and to the vesting in the Superintendent of the piece of land described in the Third Schedule hereto and to the disposal thereof shall come into operation immediately on the passing hereof.

The residue of this Act shall come into operation on payment by the Corporation aforesaid to the Superintendent for the time being of the Province of Wellington of the sum of twenty thousand pounds but if the said sum is not paid or satisfied within three months from the passing of this Act the said residue of this Act shall not come into operation.

New Clause to stand as Clause 23.

The principal moneys secured by every debenture issued under this Act shall when the same become payable be a debt of the Corporation aforesaid to the holders for the time being of such debentures respectively and the interest secured by every such debenture shall when the same becomes payable be a debt of the Corporation aforesaid to the holders for the time being of the coupon for such interest respectively and every sum of money due by the Corporation aforesaid under this provision shall be recoverable by action against the Corporation aforesaid and payable out of any moneys from time to time applicable by law for the general purposes of the Corporation aforesaid.
