## ANALYSIS.

Title
Preamble

1. After five years' service remission certificates for £30. For each six months' active service, remission certificate for £5

2. Short Title.

An Act to fix the sums for which the Superintendent of Title the Province of Hawke's Bay may issue to Volunteers and Militiamen Remission Certificates for the Purchase of Land.

WHEREAS it is enacted by the "Volunteers' Land Act Preamble 1865" that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent of any Province to grant to Volunteers and Militiamen who shall have served as mentioned in the said Act certificates entitling them to the remission of such sums as the Superintendent of a Province may with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof appoint in the purchase of land within the said Province under any law or regulation for the time being in force within it for the disposal of waste lands of the Crown not exceeding the sums mentioned in the scale contained in the said Act.

Be it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—

Provided that no officer, Volunteer or Militiaman, shall be entitled to such certificate who has already received any land in payment or consideration of his services; and that any such certificate shall become void if not presented in payment for land within one year from the date of the granting of such certificate.
