BE IT ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—

A sum of £59,954 2s 7d to be applied for the service of the Province for the year ending 30th June, 1865.

1. Out of the revenue of the Province of Marlborough subject to appropriation by the Superintendent and Provincial Council thereof there may be issued and applied any sums of money not exceeding the several sums hereinatter specified that is to say for defraying the charge of the Government of the said Province for the year ending the thirtieth day of June one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five the sum of £59,954 2s. 7d. to be appropriated to the several purposes following:

Treasurer to pay money on warrant of Superintendent. 2. The Provincial Treasurer of this Province shall issue and pay from time to time any sum or sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively specified to such persons and in such portions as the Superintendent for the time being shall by warrants to be granted by him from time to time direct and such Treasurer shall in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such warrants and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been so paid shall be a full discharge to the said Treasurer for the sums for which such receipts shall have been given and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his credit on account accordingly.

Indemnity for excess of expenditure.

3. And whereas the actual expenditure for the Provincial Government and Public Works has exceeded the sum authorised by the Appropriation Act for the year commencing the 1st day of July, 1863, and ending on the 30th day of June, 1864, by the sum of £5,141 18s. 4d., according to the items enumerated in the Schedule hereunto annexed. And whereas the said expenditure was reasonable and necessary.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED as follows: The Superintendent of the said Province is hereby indemnified for the issue by him of warrants for the said sum of £5,141 18s. 4d. and for which amount the Provincial Treasurer shall be allowed and is hereby authorised to take credit on his account.

4. The Short Title of this Act shall be the "Appropriation Act, 1864."
