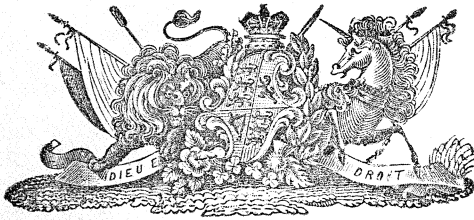

**W**HEREAS an act was passed by the Superintendent [of the Province of Marlborough, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, Session I., No. 3, intituled "The Alteration of Roads Act, 1860:" And whereas it is expedient that the said act be repealed: Be it, therefore, enacted by the Superintendent of the said Province of Marlborough, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, as follows:—

1. The "Alteration of Roads Act, 1860," shall be and the same is hereby repealed.
