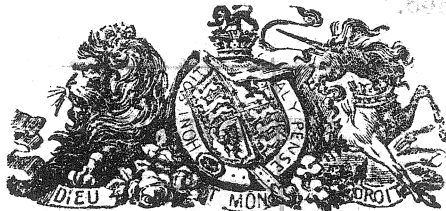

AN ACT to vest Lands in certain persons in trust as Public Cemeteries.

Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Lands mentioned in the
First Schedule hereto should be set apart and appropriated
as Public Cemeteries and that the same should be vested in Trustees.

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Pro-
vince of Marlborough, with the advice and consent of the Provincial
Council thereof, as follows :—

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Public Cemeteries
Act, 1873."

Short Title.

II. The Lands specified in the First Schedule hereto shall be
Public Cemeteries and shall in all respects (subject to the provisions
of this Act) be subject to the provisions of "The Public Cemeteries
Act 1868" made and passed by the Superintendent and Provincial
Council of the said Province.

Certain Lands to be
subject to Public Ce-
meteries Act, 1868.

Power of Trustees.

III. That the persons named in the said Second Schedule shall be the Board of Trustees for the management of the said Cemeteries respectively and shall have all the powers and in all things be subject to the same conditions as Boards of Trustees under the said "Public Cemeteries Act 1868."

Section No. 105, in the District of Picton Suburban, containing by admeasurement Five Acres, One Rood, and Nineteen Perches (5a. 1r. 19p.)
