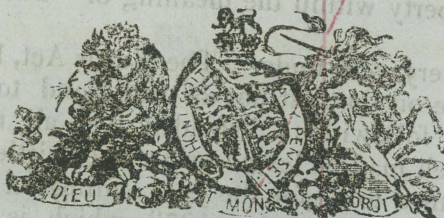

THE ROADS ACT AMENDMENT ACT, 1873.

IN THE THIRTY-SIXTH YEAR OF THE REIGN OF HER MAJESTY
QUEEN VICTORIA.

AN ACT to exempt certain Lands from the provisions of "The Roads Act, 1872." Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient that certain Lands should be exempted from the provisions of "The Roads Act, 1872," and that certain other Lands should also be exempted from the rates payable under the said Act. Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Roads Act Amendment Act, 1873." Short Title.

Certain Crown Lands Reserves, &c., not rateable.

II. All Crown Lands and Reserves vested in the Superintendent unless occupied by private persons and Lands set apart for places of public worship and schools and for the residences of officiating ministers and the masters of public schools shall not be rateable property within the meaning of "The Roads Act, 1872."

Financial year.

III. Every year under "The Roads Act, 1872," shall be deemed to commence on the first day of July, and to end on the thirtieth day of June following: Provided that all rates which shall have been or which may be levied before the thirtieth day of June, 1873, shall be deemed to be for the year ending on that day, but this shall not invalidate any rate for 1873 which is not completed by the 30th June, 1873.

Returns to Superintendent.

IV. Every Board shall on or before the thirtieth of September in each year furnish the Superintendent of the Province with a copy of the Assessment for its District, and shall likewise, on or before the thirty-first day of January in each year, furnish a return of all rates collected up to and inclusive of the thirty-first day of December, and the assessments and returns so made shall form the basis on which a distribution of public money shall be made.
