

IN THE TWENTY-EIGHTH YEAR OF THE REIGN OF HER MAJESTY QUEEN VICTORIA.

ANALYSIS.

Title.

1. Superintendent may let land specified in the schedule for any term not exceeding fourteen years.

- 2. Rent to be paid to Provincial Treasurer and to be deemed part of the revenue.

 3. Short Title.

AN ACT to empower the Superintendent to let Public Reserves for Title. any term not exceeding fourteen years.

HEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand intituled Preamble the "Public Reserves Act 1854," all the lands specified in the schedule hereto have become vested in the Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough: And whereas it is expedient that the Superintendent should be authorised to let the said lands for a term not exceeding fourteen years. Be it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent from time to time by public auction of which not less than one month's notice shall be given in some newspaper in gene-

ral circulation in the province to let all or any of the lands specified in the Schedule hereto for any term not exceeding fourteen years in possession and subject to such conditions as the Superintendent and his Executive Council shall proclaim: Provided always that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent to lease the block of land numbered known as the Clarence Shearing Reserve to one or more runholders in the Clarence upon trust for the purposes for which it was originally reserved without going to auction on such terms as the Superintendent may determine.

Rent to be paid to Provincial Treasurer, and to be deemed part of the revenue.

2. The rents issues and profits arising from leasing the said lands shall from time to time be paid and accounted for to the Provincial Treasurer of the province or other person acting in his behalf and shall be deemed part of the revenue of the province subject to appropriation.

Short Title

3. The short title of this Act shall be "The Public Reserves Management Act 1865."
