WHEREAS, by an Act passed by the Superintendent and Pro-Preamble. vincial Council of the Province of Nelson, in Session V., No. 6, initial of the Province of Nelson, in Session V., No. 6, initial of the Cattle Branding Act, 1858," certain penalties are authorised to be imposed, which might, in the aggregate, amount to upwards of One hundred pounds: And whereas it is expedient to limit the amount of penalties to be

imposed under that Act: Be it therefore enacted, by the Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof :---

Penalties not in any case.

1. That no penalty or penalties, to be imposed in any one to exceed £100 case under the authority of the said recited Act, shall exceed the sum of One hundred pounds.

Short Title.

2. This Act shall be termed and may be cited as "The Cattle Branding Amendment Act, 1859."
