Preamble.

Whereas by an Ordinance made and passed by the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Nelson, intituled "An Ordinance to Increase the Number of Members of the Provincial Council, and to alter the Electoral Districts of the Province of Nelson," certain Electoral Districts are constituted for the election of members of the Provincial Council: And

whereas it is expedient that the District of Motueka constituted by the said Ordinance should be divided into two districts as hereinafter provided: Be it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, as follows:—

- 1. The Electoral District of Motueka constituted by the Motueka Dissaid Ordinance shall be divided into two districts for the elect-trict to be ion of Members of the Provincial Council, to be called respect-tively the Motueka and Moutere Districts.
- 2. The Motueka District shall comprise the Motueka, Ri-Boundaries of waka, Sandy Bay, and Astrolabe Districts; and the Moutere District shall comprise the Moutere District, as the said districts are more particularly defined and delineated in the plan hereunto annexed.
- 3. After the next dissolution of the Provincial Council the Number of Motueka District shall return two members, and the Moutere shall return one member.
