AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE SUPERINTENDENT TO LET THE GOVERNMENT WHARF AT THE PORT OF NELSON, AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF THE SAME.

ANALYSIS.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, a Wharf has recently been erected at the Port of Nelson by the Provincial Government, and it is expedient to authorise the Superintendent to let the same, and to make

rules and regulations for the management thereof: Be it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent with the advice Superintendent may of his Executive Council, from time to time, to make all such make Rules, rules and regulations as may be expedient for managing and &c., for the protecting the said wharf, and the buildings and appurtenances management thereto belonging, and fixing and levying the amount of tolls of Governand dues to be taken thereat, the conducting of business and ment Wharf. traffic thereon and on the approach thereto, and from time to time such rules and regulations to alter.

2. The rules and regulations already issued by the Superin-Rules already tendent shall be deemed to have been issued under the authority issued authority rised by this of this Act.

3. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent, with such Penalties may advice as aforesaid by any such regulations as aforesaid, to be imposed for impose reasonable penalties not exceeding Five pounds for each of rules impose reasonable penalties not exceeding Five pounds for each breach of such regulations.

4. All regulations imposing any penalty for the breach Rules to be thereof shall be painted or printed in legible characters, and posted up at posted in some conspicuous place at the approach to such Wharf. wharf.

5. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent, with such advice Wharf may be as aforesaid, from time to time to lease the said wharf, and tolls leased. to be taken thereat, by public auction for any term not exceeding three years at one time, and at such rent, and on such conditions as he may think fit.

6. All penalties incurred under the authority of this Act may Penalties may be recovered in a summary manner before any Justice of the be recovered in a summary Peace. manner.

7. This Act shall be termed and may be cited as the Short Title. "Government Wharf Act, 1862."
