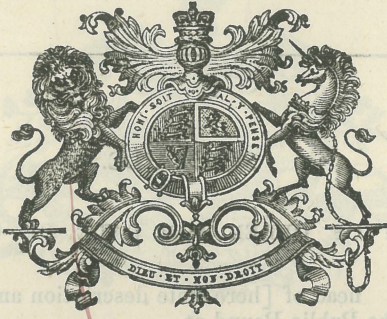

An ACT to amend the "Impounding Act 1861."

Title.

[Assented to June 13, 1873.]

BE it enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Nelson with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows :—

Preamble.

1. Clause 24 of the Act passed by the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Nelson, intituled "The Impounding Act 1861" shall be read as if the words "nor less than five pounds" at the end of the clause had been omitted.

Clause 24 of Impounding Act amended.

2. Whenever any order for the sale of Cattle shall be made by any Justice under the authority of the said Act, such order may be in the form or to the effect set forth in the schedule hereto.

Form of Order for Sale.

3. Clause 23 of the "Impounding Act 1861" is hereby repealed, and the following substituted: Provided always that nothing herein contained

tained shall extend or be construed to prevent the owner or occupier of any land trespassed upon, and being substantially fenced, from waiving ordinary damage herein provided, and claiming in any competent Court full satisfaction for any special damage sustained by him in consequence of any trespass.

FORM OF ORDER FOR SALE OF CATTLE.
