ANALYSIS:

Preamble.

1. Superintendents may lease Public Wharves.

An ACT to provide for the Leasing of Public Wharves in the Province of Nelson.

[Assented to 20th June, 1868.]

BE it enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, with the advice of the Provincial Council thereof, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent, with the advice of his Executive Council, from time to time to lease by public auction in the district in which the same may be situated, any public wharf, quay, pier, or jetty, belonging to the Provincial Government of the said Province, or of which it shall have the control or management, together with the buildings and appurtenances thereunto belonging, and the tolls to be taken thereat, for any term not exceeding three years at a time, on such conditions as he may think fit.

Superintendents may lease Public Wharves.
