PURSUANT to section 2 (2) of the Apiaries Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Apiaries Act Amendment Order 1980.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Diseases of bees—(1) The First Schedule to the Apiaries Act 1969 is hereby amended by adding the item “*Varroa (Varroa jacobsoni)*.”.

(2) The Third Schedule to the said Act is hereby amended by inserting, before the item “*Nosema (Nosema apis)*.”, the item “*Chalkbrood (Ascospaera apis)*.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order adds the names of 2 bee diseases to the Schedules to the Apiaries Act 1969.
