- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Alcoholism and Drug Addiction Institutions Order 1969.
- 2. Institutions certified—Each of the hospitals named in the Schedule to this order is hereby certified as an institution under the Alcoholism and Drug Addiction Act 1966.
