PURSUANT to the Alcoholism and Drug Addiction Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Alcoholism and Drug Addiction Institution Order 1975.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1975.

2. Institution certified—The Cook Hospital, Gisborne, is hereby certified as an institution under the Alcoholism and Drug Addiction Act 1966.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 April 1975, effects the certification, as an institution under the Alcoholism and Drug Addiction Act 1966, of the Cook Hospital, Gisborne.
