THE ARTIFICIAL AIDS NOTICE 1964, AMENDMENT NO. 1

Pursuant to regulation 4 of the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Outpatients) Regulations 1947,* the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Artificial Aids Notice 1964, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Artificial Aids Notice 1964† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. Clause 4 of the principal notice is hereby amended by adding to paragraph (a) the words "or, in the case of an artificial arm, hand, leg, or foot, employed or engaged by the Disabled Servicemen's Re-establish-

ment League".

3. Clause 4 of the principal notice is hereby further amended by inserting in paragraph (e), after the words "Hospital Board", the words "or, in the case of an artificial arm, hand, leg, or foot, employed or engaged by the Disabled Servicemen's Re-establishment League".

4. Clause 7 of the principal notice is hereby amended by adding to paragraph (a) the words "or, in the case of an artificial arm, hand, leg, or foot, employed or engaged by the Disabled Servicemen's Reestablishment League".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice extends the class of person who may recommend the supply and repair of an artificial limb to include those orthopaedic surgeons employed or engaged by the Disabled Servicemen's Re-establishment League.
