

1966/124**THE ARTIFICIAL AIDS NOTICE 1964, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to regulation 4 of the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Outpatients) Regulations 1947*, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Artificial Aids Notice 1964, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Artificial Aids Notice 1964† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. Clause 3 of the principal notice is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

“(e) Understockings for female amputees are hereby prescribed as artificial aids that may be supplied for outpatients of public hospitals.”
