THE AVERAGE ATTENDANCE REGULATIONS, 1936.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Education Act, 1914, and all other powers enabling in that behalf.

Date on which the regulations were made: 14th day of October, 1936.

Date of notification in Gazette: 15th day of October, 1936.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Average Attendance Regulations, 1936.

2. These regulations shall be read together and form part of the regulations relating to-attendance registers and returns made by Order in Council dated 10th December, 1928*, as amended from time to time; public schools, salaries, grading, staffing, house-allowances, &c., made by Order in Council dated 12th January, 1925⁺, as amended from time to time; payments to Education Boards made by Order in Council dated 16th January, 1922⁺; additional grants to Education Boards for incidental expenses of School Committees made by Order in Council dated 11th October, 1920§; Native schools made by Order in Council dated 23rd June, 1931||, as amended.

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1937.

4. Notwithstanding anything in any regulation, 95 per centum of the average number on the roll of any public school (excluding the secondary department of any district high school) or of any Native school for the days on which the school is open during the period commencing on 7th September, 1936, and ending on 2nd October, 1936, and, in the case of the secondary department of any district high school, the number on the roll on the 1st day of March, 1937 (but excluding any pupil not in attendance for at least one half-day during the fortnight preceding the 1st day of March, 1937), shall be deemed to be the average attendance on which such school or department shall be classified for the year commencing on the 1st day of February, 1937, and in the case of public schools shall be deemed to be the average attendance to be taken into account for the purpose of computing the amounts of the grants to Education Boards for incidental allowances for School Committees and for general purposes for the year 1937.

5. The regulation made by Order in Council dated 27th March, 1936, and published in the *Gazette* of 2nd April, 1936, at page 676, is revoked.
