**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Acts and Regulations Publication Act Commencement Order (No. 2) 1990.

**2. Commencement of sections 30 and 32**—Sections 30 and 32 of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989 shall come into force on the 31st day of December 1990.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force on 31 December 1990 sections 30 and 32 of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989.

Section 30 omits the name of the Government Printing Office from the First Schedule to the Ombudsmen Act 1975 (which Schedule lists the Departments and organisations to which that Act applies).

Section 32 omits the name of the Government Printing Office from the First Schedule to the State Sector Act 1988 (which Schedule lists the Departments of the Public Service).
