**ORDER IN COUNCIL.**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 4th day of  
February, 1942.

Present :

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.**

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

---

**REGULATIONS.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Air Board Emergency Regulations 1942.

2. (1) While these regulations are in force the reference in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 12 of the Air Force Act, 1937, to "Three other members (being officers of any of His Majesty's Air Forces)" shall be read as a reference to four other such members, and the membership of the Air Board shall be temporarily increased accordingly.

(2) Any person who for the time being is authorized, pursuant to section 5 of the Public Service Act, 1912, to act for the Air Secretary during his temporary absence or incapacity shall, while his appointment continues in force, be deemed to be a member of the Air Board, but shall be entitled to act as such only in the absence of the Air Secretary.
