THE ANIMAL BRANDING FEES REGULATIONS 1976

PURSUANT to section 107 of the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Animal Branding Fees Regulations 1976.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1976.

2. Registration and transfer fee—The fee for the registration or transfer of a brand shall be \$3 for each brand to be registered or transferred.

3. Standard animal mark fee—The fee for the registration of a standard animal mark shall be \$5.

4. Revocation—The Stock Branding Regulations 1957* are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their

These regulations replace the Stock Branding Regulations 1957, which were made under the Stock Act 1908. The Stock Act 1908 was repealed by the Animals Act 1967, and these regulations use the language of that Act, and at the same time increase the fee for registration or transfer of a brand from \$1 to \$3, and the fee for registration of a standard animal mark from \$2.10 to \$5.
