

THE ANIMAL BRANDING FEES REGULATIONS 1982

Pursuant to section 107 of the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Animal Branding Fees Regulations 1982.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1982.
- 2. Registration and transfer fee—The fee for the registration or transfer of a brand shall be \$10 for each brand to be registered or transferred.
- 3. Standard animal mark fee—The fee for the registration of a standard animal mark shall be \$20.
- **4. Revocation**—The Animal Branding Fees Regulations 1976* are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 March 1982, increase both the fee for the registration or transfer of a brand from \$3 to \$10 and the fee for registration of a standard animal mark from \$5 to \$20.
