# ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 25th day of March 1985

PURSUANT to section 107 of the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

# REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Animal Branding Fees Regulations 1985.
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1985.
- 2. Registration and transfer fee—The fee for the registration or transfer of a brand shall be \$20 for each brand to be registered or transferred.
- **3. Standard animal mark fee**—The fee for the registration of a standard animal mark shall be \$40.
- **4. Revocation**—The Animal Branding Fees Regulations 1982\* are hereby consequentially revoked.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations which come into force on 1 April 1985, increase the fee for the registration or transfer of a brand from \$10 to \$20 and the fee for registration of a standard animal mark from \$20 to \$40.
