**THE ABRASIVE BLASTING REGULATIONS 1958,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 1st day of April 1975

Present:

THE HON. R. J. TIZARD PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Factories Act 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Abrasive Blasting Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Abrasive Blasting Regulations 1958* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Metrication—Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (5) and also from subclause (6), wherever it appears, the expression "50 ft." and substituting in each case the expression "15 metres".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations substitute 15 metres for 50 ft as the distance from blasting within which workers must be provided with protective clothing.
