PURSUANT to section 1 (2) of the Accident Compensation Act 1972 and section 1 (3) of the Accident Compensation Amendment Act (No. 2) 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation Act Commencement Order (No. 2) 1973.

2. Commencement of specified provisions of Acts—Sections 4, 5, 43, 44, 48 to 50, 54 to 90, 103 to 105, 107 to 139, 142 to 151, 173 to 175, 179, 183, and 184 of the Accident Compensation Act 1972, and sections 2, 4, 5, 14 to 35, 37 to 52, 54, 57, and 59 to 62 of the Accident Compensation Amendment Act (No. 2) 1973 shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1974.
