THE ACCIDENT COMPENSATION (PRESCRIBED AMOUNTS FOR CALCULATION AND PAYMENT OF LEVIES) ORDER 1977

PURSUANT to sections 78 (9) and 181 (2) (b) of the Accident Compensation Act 1972, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Prescribed Amounts for Calculation and Payment of Levies) Order 1977.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1977.

2. Interpretation—In this order the expression "the Act" means the Accident Compensation Act 1972.

3. Application—This order shall apply for the purpose of calculation and payment of levies by every self-employed person who is required by section 78 of the Act to deliver a statement of earnings as a self-employed person.

4. Prescribed amounts for purposes of section 78 of the Act—For the purposes of section 78 of the Act,— Con. Regs.—14*

Accident Compensation (Prescribed Amounts for 1977/75 Calculation and Payment of Levies) Order 1977

- (a) In relation to every self-employed person who has worked an average of 30 hours or more per week as a self-employed person during the 12 months immediately preceding the 1st day of October of the year in which a statement of earnings is required by that section to be delivered, the prescribed amount shall be \$3,600:
- (b) In relation to every other self-employed person, the prescribed amount shall be \$1,000.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order is made pursuant to section 78 (9) of the Accident Compensation Act 1972 (as now amended), and increases the prescribed minimum amount on which a full time self-employed person (as defined) pays levy on his earnings as a self-employed person to \$3,600. For other self-employed persons the prescribed amount is \$1,000.

Calculation of the levy to be paid will be in accordance with section 78 (5).
