

THE ACCIDENT COMPENSATION (PRESCRIBED AMOUNT FOR SECTION 113) ORDER 1979

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 12th day of February 1979

Present:

The Right Hon. B. E. Talboys presiding in Council Pursuant to the Accident Compensation Act 1972, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Prescribed Amount for Section 113) Order 1979.
 - (2) This order shall come into effect on the 1st day of April 1979.
- 2. Application—This order shall apply for the purpose of calculating earnings related compensation for any period of incapacity which occurs on or after the date of commencement of this order, whether the accident occurred before, on, or after that date.
- 3. Prescribing increased amount for the purposes of section 113—For the purposes of section 113 of the Accident Compensation Act 1972, the prescribed amount shall be \$288.
- 4. Revocation—The Accident Compensation (Prescribed Amounts) Order 1978 is consequentially amended by revoking subclause (2) of clause 3, and clause 5.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the maximum amount of earnings related compensation payable from \$240 to \$288 per week.
