**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of November 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Accident Compensation Act 1972, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

---

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Prescribed Amount for Section 118) Order 1977.

(2) This order shall come into effect on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Application**—This order shall apply for the purpose of calculating earnings related compensation for any period of incapacity which occurs on or after the date of the commencement of this order, whether the accident occurred before, on, or after that date.

**3. Prescribing increased amount for purpose of section 118**—For the purposes of section 118 of the Accident Compensation Act 1972, the prescribed amount shall be \$90, but subject to the powers of the Commission to increase this amount within the limits specified in section 118 (5) of that Act.

**4. Revocation**—The Accident Compensation (Prescribed Amounts) Order 1976\* is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3) of clause 4.
